You and your students are invited to attend the above Championships on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2020 in Deeside Leisure Centre, North Wales, Chester Road West, Queensferry, Flintshire, CH5 1SA. Junior competitors' 10:00 a.m. Adult competitors' 12 noon.

If you and any of your Black Belts could officiate on the day, it would be greatly appreciated. Please give numbers and names of officials with entries.

Competitor's tickets cost £12.00 (1 event), £15 all events. Spectators will cost £6.00. This year we have taken out musical patterns but have introduced a Team Pattern category in its place. Team Patterns will be a pay and enter on the day event.

We would like all entries and payment in by **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> January** at the latest, to allow the draw to be organised in advance. It is important that entries are in by this date.

Please make sure you look at the divisions carefully to minimise mistakes on the day.

# **SPARRING**

Categories: All Sparring POINT STOP

Students will compete in one of the following belt categories:

White/Yellow/Green Belts Blue Belts/Red Belts Junior Black Belts Adult Black Belts

Each round 1 1/2 Minutes Black belts only will consist of two rounds in the final.

# <u>Coloured Belt</u> <u>Men (Three weight divisions)</u>

Light weight Up to and including 70kg.

Middleweight Over 70kg up to and including 80kg.

Heavyweight Over 80kg

**Executive\*\*** 40 years old and above

(All will compete in one weight division and this will be point stop.)

# Coloured Belt Ladies (Three weight divisions)

Light weight Up to and including 60kg.

Middleweight Over 60kg up to and including 65kg.

Heavyweight Over 65kg

**Executive\*\*** 40 years old and above

(All will compete in one weight division and this will be point stop.)

## Juniors – Up to & including 16 years old (Five height divisions)

Tiny tots Up to and including 4'
Peewee Up to and including 4'6"

Light weight Over 4'6" up to and including 5' Middleweight Over 5' up to and including 5'6"

Heavyweight Over 5'6"

# **Adult Black Belts**

Men (A single category – Point stop rules)

Executive\*\* 40 years old and above

(All will compete in one weight division and this will be point stop.)

Ladies (A single category – Point stop rules)

Executive\*\* 40 years old and above

(All will compete in one weight division and this will be point stop.)

# **PATTERNS**

## **Categories:**

Students will compete in one of the following belt categories:

White/Yellow Belts Green Belts Blue Belts Red Belts

#### **Executive Patterns**

White/Yellow/Green Blue/Red

Any pattern up to grade will be allowed for coloured belts

Black Belts Separate - Any Black belt pattern Allowed.

#### **Executive Black Belt Patterns over 40's**

Tiny Tots only (this year boys & girls will be separate)

Tiny Tots White/Yellow/Green Blue/Red

# **Team Patterns**

This year we will add in team patterns, divisions are as follows:

Juniors coloured belts – white – yellow – green together any pattern

Juniors coloured belts Blue – Red – black belts together any pattern

Adults – same as above.

3 students per team.

## **DESTRUCTION – Black Belts only**

Ladies hand – any technique (including elbow) Ladies foot – any standing kick

Men's Hand – any technique not including elbow Men's Foot – any standing kick

# **Speed Kicking**

All juniors after they have finished their pattern division can compete in a Speed Kicking category. It will consist of 30 seconds of turning kicks at shoulder level and the foot must return to the floor after each kick. The student with the most kicks wins.

If the same score is reached then time increases by 15 seconds until you have a winner.
