To be considered for promotion, you must have:

- Paid membership fees consistently
- A current TAGB licence which is valid through the grading period
- A clean, pressed white TAGB training uniform (no club doboks or competition uniform)
- A TAGB training manual
- Attended no less than 75% of sessions available
- Returned a completed application form
- Paid the £30 external grading fee via PayPal link on the website 'Grading' page (PayPal or cash only – please do not pay via bank transfer)
- All of the above by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024

**There is no obligation to take the assessment, it is purely optional. You may continue to train at your current grade if you wish.**
