Our next grading is available for you to apply for promotion within the Tae Kwon-Do Association of Great Britain via a practical assessment before a grading examiner.

If you are deemed to be of the required standard, you will be promoted to the next kup grade within the TAGB syllabus and presented with a certificate and new belt.

The grading will be held at our Stechford TAGB main club venue;

Colebourne Primary School, Stechford Road, Hodge Hill, B34 6BJ

All junior members must be accompanied by one adult spectator for the duration. The dojang will be available from 5:30pm, please ensure that you arrive at this time for registration. Any late comers will not gain access to the dojang and therefore will not grade on this occasion.

Photography / video is not permitted during the grading as we operate under strict examination conditions and adhere to the BTC safeguarding policy.

To be considered for promotion, you must have:

- Paid membership fees consistently
- A current TAGB licence which is valid through the grading period
- A clean, pressed white TAGB training uniform (no tee shirts or competition uniform)
- A TAGB training manual
- Attended no less than 75% of sessions available
- Returned a completed application form
- Paid the £30 external grading fee via PayPal link on the website 'Grading' page (PayPal or cash only – please do not pay via bank transfer)
- All of the above by Friday 24th September 2021

There is no obligation to take the assessment, it is purely optional. You may continue to train at your current grade if you wish.
